## **9. Abstracts and full-text papers**

The International Society of Palaeogeography cordially invites palaeogeographers and experts of relevant disciplines to submit abstracts and full-text papers, and join the 4<sup>th</sup> International Conference of Palaeogeography.

- (1) The requirements of the abstracts

Each abstract should include title, author's name, author's affiliation, abstract, keywords. Do not include figures and tables. For detailed requirements please refer to the typesetting pattern of the *Journal of Palaeogeography*.

- (2) The requirements of the full-text paper

In order to improve the academic quality, all the applicants who prefer oral presentations should submit their full-text papers prior to July 1, 2019. For all the papers, please use the templates provided by the *Journal of Palaeogeography*. All the papers must be submitted in English with a quality of spelling and grammar suitable for publication, the sooner, the better. Chinese authors are also required to submit Chinese abstracts simultaneously.

After submission, the papers will be sent for peer-reviewing by the conference. Authors should revise their manuscripts according to the reviewing comments and send back their revised manuscripts to the conference on time. The revised papers, if being accepted by the conference, will be orally presented at the conference and will be published in the *Journal of Palaeogeography*. This is the most effective measure to promote the development and innovation of the *Journal of Palaeogeography*.

## **10. Awards for the best presentations by young scientists/students**

The conference will award the best presentations by young scientists/students, with the following eligibility criteria:

(1) Authors should submit the full texts (in English) of their manuscripts according to the above-mentioned requirements, revise their manuscripts according to the reviewing comments and send back their revised manuscripts to the conference on time, and submit 5 copies of the full texts of their final manuscripts before attending the conference;

(2) Only the first (corresponding) author of a manuscript can apply for this award;

(3) The applicant should be less than 40 years old;

(4) The applicant should present the manuscripts at the conference orally.

(5) The winners' papers will be published in the *Journal of Palaeogeography*.

Awards for the best presentations by young scientists/students will consist of a

certificate, monographs, financial incentives, as well as exemption from the post-conference field excursion fee. If the winners submit their papers to other journals, the conference will cancel the awards.

The conference sincerely invites experts of palaeogeography and related disciplines to donate 5 copies of monographs as awards for the best presentations by young scientists/students.

### **11. Oral and poster presentations**

Three days of conference will be scheduled on September 20–22, 2019.

The technical programme includes oral presentations as well as poster presentations.

The official language at the conference is English.

### **12. Post-conference field excursions**

Three post-conference field excursions are selectable:

(1) The Mesoproterozoic—Neoproterozoic strata and microbialites in Jixian, Tianjing (Sept. 23–25, 2019, about 2000 RMB)

(2) The Early Cretaceous fan delta-deep lake system in Luanping Basin, Hebei Province. (Sept. 23–25, 2019, about 2000 RMB)

(3) The Neoproterozoic-Paleozoic sedimentology in Beijing (Sept. 23–25, 2019, about 1600 RMB)

### **13. Fees**

(1) Registration fee (including the conference dinner fee): 2600 RMB; student rate: 1300 RMB; accompany member rate: 1300 RMB;

(2) Accommodation fee:

1) Cuigong Hotel at China University of Petroleum (Beijing), Standard room with two single beds: about 380 RMB/Day;

2) Dazhaimen Hotel (about 200m from the campus), Standard room with one king-size bed or two single beds: about 450 RMB/Day;

3) Haiyou Hotel (about 600m from the campus), Standard room with two single beds: 200–280 RMB/Day;

2) The fees of Chinese members of the Editorial Committee of the *Journal of Palaeogeography* and founding members of the ISP will not be covered by the conference

since they can apply for reimbursement from their affiliations.
